

# Notice of Race

## Main & Jib Fleet 2006, Bay City Yacht Club

Bay City Yacht Club is sponsoring a Wednesday Night series. The series will be for PHRF Main & Jib racing for both monohull and multihull boats.

### Eligibility

This event is open to BCYC members as well as area sailors. The race is open to any monohull yacht over nineteen (19) feet in length or any multihull yacht over twenty-three (23) feet or with a speed potential of 700 Portsmouth or lower. Monohull boats will be split into five (5) starts: One (Spinnaker all ratings), Six (M&J PHRF 122 and below), Five (M&J PHRF 123-167), Four (M&J PHRF 168-224), and Three (M&J PHRF 225 and above). Multihull boats will have a single (1) start, Two (all multihulls) and the participants will be broken into two classes for scoring: Beach Cats and Offshore Multi-hulls

### Rules

Racing will be conducted in accordance with the following:

- The *2005-2008 ISF Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and the prescriptions of US Sailing;
- The *Notice of Race* and any amendments thereto;
- The *Sailing Instructions* and any amendments thereto.

### Entry

To enter the series, complete the *Application and Waiver*, the *PHRF Rating Application*, and submit with the appropriate Entry Fee to the BCYC M&J Fleet Captain. The cost of the series is \$35.00, \$30.00 for US Sailing members. Entries will be accepted through July 5, 2006.

### Schedule of Racing and Events

Races will be held on each Wednesday night beginning May 17th and ending August 31st. The first class starting time will be 7:05pm. See *2006 BCYC Main & Jib Fleet Schedule* for series details. Fall Series starts September 6 and ends October 11. Fall Series start time is 7:00pm for all classes.

### Skipper's Meeting

There will be a Skipper's Meeting at 7:00pm, Wednesday, May 10, 2006 at the BCYC Clubhouse.

### Sailing Instructions

*Sailing Instructions* will be available at the Skipper's Meeting.

### Scoring

Scoring will be as described in the *Sailing Instructions*.

### Awards

Twenty-two races are scheduled. There will be eight races in the spring and summer series. Your best four (4) races in each series will constitute your score. There will be six races in the fall series. Your best three (3) races in that series will constitute your score. At the end of the season, your best ten (10) races will constitute your score for the Overall Series. Trophies will be given out for the Spring Series, the Summer Series, Fall Series, and the Overall Series. A boat will qualify for awards in one fleet per series. In addition, each yacht will receive a participation award. You must (1) complete the *Application and Waiver* and pay the Entry Fee by July 5, 2006, and (2) start AND finish at least one race by August 31, 2006.
