



NOTICE of RACE

BCYC DOUBLE HANDED TOWER RACE BAY CITY YACHT CLUB MAY 26, 2007

Bay City Yacht Club is sponsoring a Double Handed Tower Race May 26, 2007. The event will be for PHRF main & jib, spinnaker, and cruising spinnaker fleets for both monohull and multihull boats.

Eligibility

This event is open to BCYC & LHYA members as well as area sailors.

The race is open to any mono hull yacht over nineteen (19) feet in length or any multihull yacht twenty-three (23) feet or over in length or with a speed potential of 700 Portsmouth or lower. Entries will be split into classes with the approximate size of each class to be eight (8) boats. Class splits will be determined by PHRF rating.

Rules

Racing will be conducted in accordance with the following:

- a) The 2005-2008 ISF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the prescriptions of US SAILING;
- b) The Notice of Race and any amendments thereto;
- c) The Sailing Instructions and any amendments thereto.

Entry

To enter the race, complete the attached Application and Waiver Form and submit it with the appropriate entry fee to the race chair, Greg Horvath (see address on the bottom of the form). The cost of this event is \$30.00 (\$35.00 for non-US Sailing members). Entries will be accepted through May 25th, 2007. Late entries will be accepted through the start of the skippers meeting May 26, 2007 with payment of an additional late fee of \$20.00.
